Log in at <https://authors.repec.org/> and click on "names" to make sure that all relevant combinations are present. In particular, make sure at least an initial is present in the middle name field and click on "suggest variations".
- Do not remove older versions of your works from your profile. They may have been cited, or they may have been published in a series with a higher impact factor. Besides, not everyone may have access to published versions, especially in developing countries.
- Encourage your publishers or employers to participate in RePEc and have their publications listed. See the [instructions](#).
- We do not automatically add citations for which we are not sure they are well classified. You can check and add what we have to propose: log in at <https://authors.repec.org/> and click on "citations".

The data presented here is experimental. It is based on a limited sample of the research output in Economics and Finance. Only material catalogued in [RePEc](#) is considered. For any citation based criterion, only works that could be parsed by the [CitEc project](#) are considered. For any ranking of people, only those registered with the [RePEc Author Service](#) can be taken into account. And for rankings of institutions, only those listed in [EDIRC](#) and claimed as affiliation by the respective, registered authors can be measured. Thus, this list is by no means based on a complete sample. You can help making this more comprehensive by encouraging more publications to be listed ([instructions](#)) and more authors to register ([form](#)).
